#### BIO

Dr. Arthur Robin is the Chief of Psychology and Director of Psychology Training at Children's Hospital of Michigan, a Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Neurosciences at Wayne State University, and a licensed psychologist practicing in Bloomfield Hills, MI. He has written four books, *ADHD in Adolescents: Diagnosis and Treatment* (1998), *Negotiating Parent-Adolescent Conflict: A Behavioral Family Systems Approach* (1989), *Defiant Teens* (with Russell Barkley and Gwen Edwards, 1999), and *Your Defiant Teen* (with Russell Barkley and Chris Benton, Feb. 2008). In 2002 he was inducted into the CHADD Hall of Fame for his contributions to the field of ADHD. He is a Co-Director of the Professional Advisory Board of the Attention Deficit Disorder Association and the Professional Advisor for CHADD of Eastern Oakland County.

#### BIO

An Adult Psychiatrist specializing in Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder in adolescents and adults, Dr. Bilkey is the Director of the Bilkey ADHD Clinics, where he has assessed over 2000 adolescents and adults with this condition. He is an Adjunct Professor, Department of Psychiatry, Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry, The University of Western Ontario. Dr. Bilkey regularly provides academic lectures concerning the topic of ADHD to educate other physicians, health care professionals, educators and parents with regard to this condition. He provides preceptorships to other physicians at his clinics in Stratford and Barrie and is Adjunct Mentor for the Ontario College of Family Physicians Collaborative Mental Health Project. Dr. Bilkey is an Academic Consultant for the Ontario Medical Association in the Physicians Helping Physicians Program. He also has a strong research interest, having participated in one of the largest studies (702 subjects) conducted

regarding medications for Adult ADHD. He provides consultation liaison for universities and colleges in Ontario, and presently is studying ADHD and its comorbidities in this age group. ©2007 Bilkey ADHD Clinic. All Rights Reserved.

### DR. TAMIESON DOEY

#### BIO

Dr. Doey completed her residency in psychiatry at the University of Western Ontario and concurrently earned her diploma in child psychiatry. After completing undergraduate studies at Columbia University and the University of Guelph, she received her medical degree from McMaster University. She completed three years of post graduate training in internal medicine at the Wellesley Hospital in Toronto and at McMaster before leaving to practice family medicine in Essex. During that time, she pursued a number of other interests including third party assessments and WSIB assessments for work related illnesses, the creation of "Renew, Review, Relax" a series of weekend programs in continuing medical education for women in family medicine, and research as an investigator in ALLHATS, a large multi-centre antihypertensive trial sponsored by the NIH.

In 1997, Dr. Doey began her involvement with the Department of Psychiatry in Windsor, serving as the hospitalist for psychiatric patients at all three hospitals. As well, she established a shared care clinic at CMHA that provided holistic care for seriously mentally ill patients. Prompted by the need for psychiatric specialists and educators, she applied for the Re-entry program of Ontario and was accepted into the residency program at Western in 2002. She has been actively involved in the division of child psychiatry, serving as its resident representative, the COPE representative in 2003-2005, as well as the chief resident for 2005. She has received two research grants to study the use, efficacy and outcomes of the use of atypical antipsychotics on patients under age 18 in Canada. She was awarded the best CME award in 2003 and 2004, and the best resident award in 2004. She is the head of the division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry in Windsor Ontario. She has been involved in teaching medical students, and is currently program co-ordinator for child and adolescent psychiatry teaching as well as the Academic Director for Postgraduate studies in Psychiatry for the South Western Ontario Medical Education Network (SWOMEN), a division

of The University of Western Ontario and an adjunct professor of the faculty of the University of Western Ontario, teaching in Windsor and London. She has recently published articles on two areas of interest, the use and monitoring of atypical antipsychotics in the treatment of children and evaluation and treatment of suicidal youth.

Dr. Doey is married to Douglas Doey, head of the technical department at Kingsville District High School, the mother of four and grandmother of two. She and her husband own and operate the Chelsea Spa and Retreat Inc.
